- Litter announcement posts listing the names of the puppies in each litter (this will be posted when the last puppy is delivered to their raiser home)

- Posts, photos and updates from other puppy raisers, breeder custodians, graduates and more
- Remember: this is a public page – please be careful when posting any personal information

Photos are easy to download and save, post or print from Flickr! Click on the photo, then click on the download symbol on the bottom right of the photo and choose the size you want to download to your computer.
