Specific Bequest to the Guide Dogs for the Blind

Specific Bequest to the Guide Dogs for the Blind
A specific bequest gives a specific item or specific piece of property to Guide Dogs. Such bequests are fulfilled first, before cash and residuary bequests. If you dispose of the specified
property during your lifetime, there will be no bequest to Guide Dogs.
"I give (describe asset) to Guide Dogs for the Blind, Inc. of San Rafael,
California, for its general purposes."
Cash Bequest to Guide Dogs for the Blind
A cash bequest provides Guide Dogs for the Blind with a specified sum of money from a donor' estate. These bequests are fulfilled second, after specific and before residuary bequests.
"I give Dollars (\$) to Guide Dogs for the Blind, Inc. of San Rafael, California, for its general purposes."
Residuary Bequest to Guide Dogs for the Blind
A residuary bequest is made from the residue, or what remains in your estate after specific and cash bequests, taxes, settlement costs and debts are satisfied.
"I give the residue (or percent of the residue) of my estate (or trust) to Guide Dogs for the Blind, Inc. of San Rafael, California, for its general purposes."
